What?

The Bayreuth International Summer School is jointly hosted by the International Office of the University of Bayreuth and the Campus Academy, the university's institute for lifelong learning and corporate education. Get support!

Tuition fees for students are 650€ and cover the costs for programme and language courses.

However, you can benefit from a special rate if:

- you are enrolled in one of our partner universities¹
- you are student of Bordeaux (200€)

The Gateway Office Bordeaux is submitting a DFJW grant proposal to support financially the participation of 15 fellows from Bordeaux, Bayreuth and PAUWES. If the proposal is accepted, the fees will be reduced to 160€ for fellows from Bordeaux and PAUWES (partial reimbursement of the fees after the event). However, if the proposal is not accepted, the regular fees will apply (special rate for Bordeaux students still apply).

Who can apply for the grant?

- Master's students or PhD candidates from Bordeaux, Bayreuth and PAUWES (5 fellows by country)
- under 30 years old
- no restriction of nationalities

What does it cover?

- a part of your programme costs
- a part of the costs for language courses

The financial support will be effective after the summer school. The full tuition fees must be paid at the time of registration. Participants get a reimbursement by the Gateway Office Bordeaux in the next weeks following the event. Please mind the administrative delay in processing the reimbursement.

DFJW support: requirements

If you're supported by the DFJW grant, you commit yourself to participate in an additional group work with the 15 DFJW grantees. It entails your participation to 6 sessions from 1 to 1,5 hours (interactive group work on following topics: "career development", "PhD or not PhD").

The reimbursement is conditioned to your attendance to all the sessions.

Once your application has been validated by our scientific coordinators, it will go through a second evaluation by the Gateway Office Bordeaux to check your eligibility to the grant. You will then receive a notification about the status of your application: refused, accepted without grant, accepted with grant.

Application documents

- CV (with your date of birth for the grant eligibility), highlighting your scientific background
- motivation letter, explaining why you would like to attend the BISS, how it is complementary to your current education path, what you expect from it...
- certificate of B2 level in English (no need if you are enrolled in a study programme completely taught in English)
